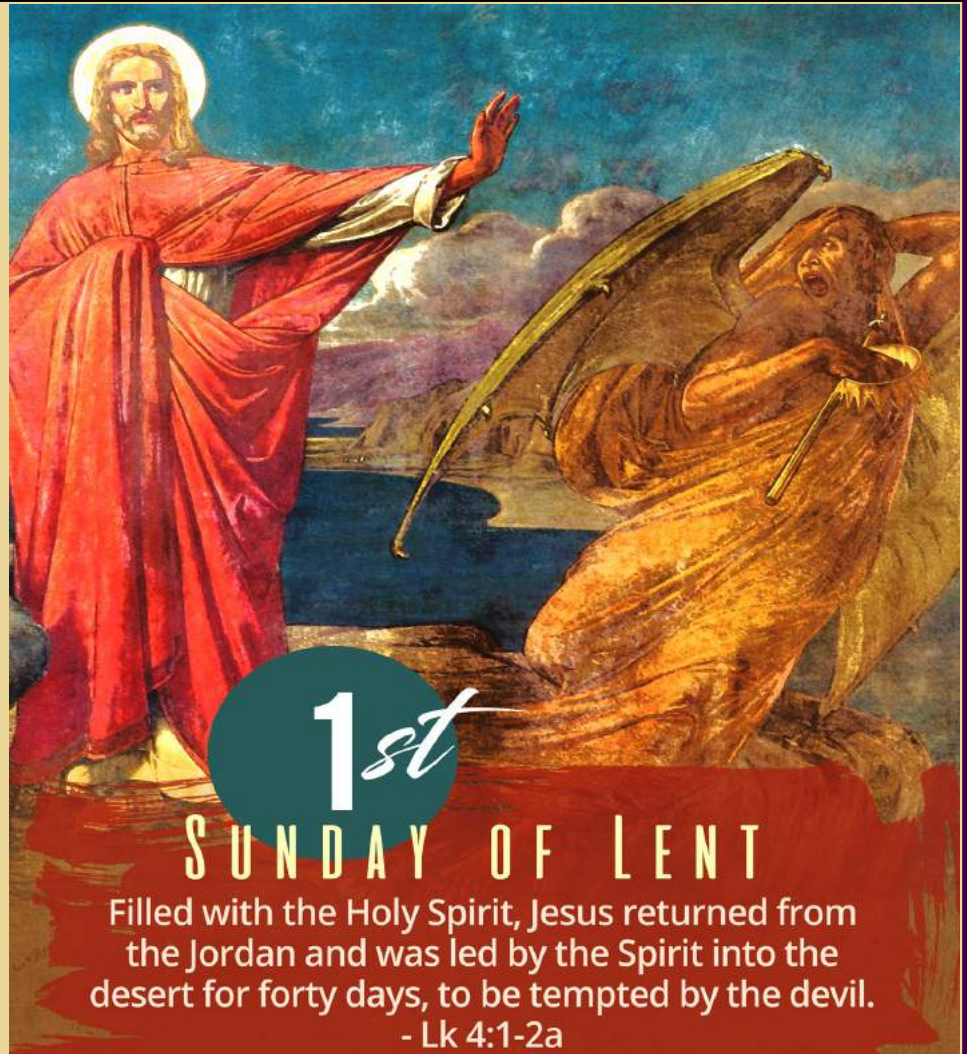

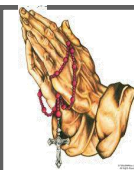

Life and Dignity of the Human Person



March is noted as **Women's History Month**. Therefore, let us ponder on the charitable mission works and social justice campaigns that have been initiated by Catholic women. Religious orders like the Dominicans, Benedictines, Loreto Sisters, and Missionaries of Charity have established convents, schools, hospitals, and nursing homes that minister to those in need regardless of their ethnicity, religious creed, or social economic status. Individuals among them are recognized internationally because of their "faith through action." They include St. Teresa of Calcutta, Sister Helen Prejean, Dorothy Day, and Lena Howard. As we celebrate Women's History Month, let us reflect on these and other women whose lives exemplify the principles of Catholic Social Teaching.

This month, **World Water Day** is recognized on March 22. Access to clean water is a basic human need and our parish is helping to meet this need by supporting Wells for Hope, a non-profit founded by Majok Marier - a former Lost Boy of Sudan. SPB is hosting a team of 12 walkers at the 2019 Walk for Water and Health that takes place this weekend on Sunday at 2 pm from the Carter Center parking lot. Funds raised from this event will be used for drilling wells in rural villages in South Sudan. As a result of SPB Parish's support of Wells for Hope, our church is a sponsor of this event.
