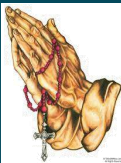

During this meeting, parishioners will “**feed their souls**” through a **simple soup supper** and a presentation by the staff of the **Catholic Charities (CC) Atlanta’s Immigration Legal Services**.

The evening’s program will feature the realities of the immigration process. The CC staff will share information about the services they provide to thousands of people each year. Along with the presentation, CC will be doing a **diaper drive** for the **Catholic Charities Atlanta’s Refugee Resettlement Program**. All size diapers are welcome, but sizes 5 and 6 are always the most needed.

All parishioners are invited to this presentation. The Social Justice Committee will provide the meal. All that is suggested is for attendees to **bring a donation of diapers**. The Social Justice Committee hopes that many parishioners will participate in this opportunity to support the “**Living Our Faith**” portion of the **St Philip Pastoral Plan Goal #3**.

Devotion to the Rosary

- Through the years, Our Lady has re-affirmed her approval of devotion to praying the rosary and her pleasure in the title “Queen of the Rosary.” To St Dominic Guzman the rosary was given as a form of gospel-preaching and prayer—to teach the mysteries of Christianity; Blessed Alan of Rupe founded the first Rosary Confraternity spreading the rosary prayer throughout Western Christendom. Our Lady promised Blessed Bartolo Longo that those who would propagate devotion to the rosary would be saved; she told Bernadette of Lourdes to pray many rosaries; at Fatima she told the three children to “say the Rosary every day to bring peace to the world and the end of war.” Popes throughout history—from Sixtus IV in 1479 to the present day— have

loved the Rosary and have urged devotion to the Rosary. Pius XI dedicated the entire month of October to the Rosary. Founders of most religious orders—Benedictines, Carmelites, Dominicans, Franciscans, others—have either commanded or recommended daily recitation of the Rosary. Our ancestors had recourse to the Rosary as an ever-ready refuge in misfortune, and as a pledge and proof of their Christian faith—Christian successes over the Turks; Penal days in Ireland bound the Irish Catholics together; religion restored in France through the rosary prayer; Mexican Catholics clung faithfully to their rosaries in the dark days of persecution. Our Lady’s Rosary is the key to open the treasury of grace to all of us!

Devoción al Rosario— A través de los años, Nuestra Señora ha reafirmado su aprobación de la devoción a rezar el Rosario y su placer en el título de “Reina del Rosario”. A San Domingo Guzmán el rosario fue dado como una forma de predicación del Evangelio y oración — para enseñar los misterios del cristianismo; El Beato Alan de Rupia fundó la primera Confraternidad del Rosario difundiendo la oración del Rosario por toda la cristiandad occidental. Nuestra Señora prometió al bendito Bartolo Longo que aquellos que propagarían la devoción al Rosario serían salvados; ella le dijo a Bernadette de Lourdes que orara muchos Rosarios; en Fátima les dijo a los tres niños que “recitaran el Rosario todos los días para traer la paz al mundo y fin a la guerra”. Los papas a lo largo de la historia — desde Sixto IV en 1479 hasta nuestros días — han amado el Rosario y han instado la devoción al Rosario. Pío XI dedicó todo el mes de octubre al Rosario. Los fundadores de la mayoría de las órdenes religiosas — Benedictinas, Carmelitas, Dominicanos, Franciscanos, otros — han ordenado o recomendado la recitación diaria del Rosario. Nuestros antepasados recurrir al Rosario como un refugio siempre listo en la desgracia, y como una promesa y prueba de su fe cristiana—los éxitos Cristianos sobre los turcos; Los días penales en Irlanda unieron a los irlandeses católicos; la religión restaurada en Francia a través de la oración del Rosario; Los Mexicanos Católicos se aferraron fielmente a sus rosarios en los días oscuros de la persecución. ¡El Rosario de Nuestra Señora es la clave para abrir el tesoro de gracia a todos nosotros!

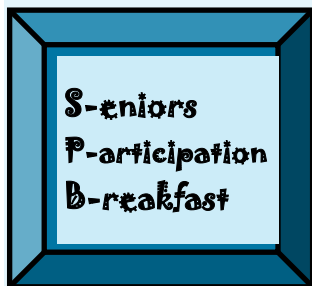

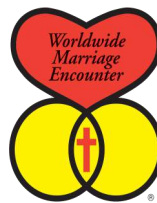
